During the guided tour of the old town we will see the imposing fortress **Hohensalzburg** towering over the city and of course the birthplace and residence of Mozart, Salzburg's most famous citizen. On our way back eastwards, we will reach classical **Vienna**, home of Strauss and many great composers. This city offers up so much wonderful architecture as well as a host of other things to see including the Spanish riding school.

Finally, cruising into Hungary, we arrive back in imperial **Budapest**, straddling the picturesque Danube. After a guided tour of this palatial city we spend the evening on board, where the Captain hosts another spectacular dinner, an excellent finale to this most exceptional and relaxing cruise.
